**<u>E-brief #1</u>**: a future with many planned pandemics

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Throughout human history, pandemics have been fairly commonplace occurrences. Lately, governments, international health agencies, and global corporate enterprises have invested considerable time and effort in discussing them. New and global public/private partnerships are being planned and implemented to mitigate the health, social, and economic impacts of these anticipated global infections.

On October 18, 2019, mere months before the 'real' coronavirus pandemic of 2020, the Johns Hopkins Center for Health Security hosted <u>Event 201</u>, a daylong simulation about managing a global coronavirus pandemic. The same agency then created a second futuristic scenario '<u>The SPARS Pandemic 2025-2028</u>' as a planning tool for preparing for future pandemics.

Closely following these events, the <u>World Health Organization</u> is now spearheading the creation of <u>a new global accord on pandemic prevention</u>, <u>preparedness</u>, and <u>response</u>.

In response, the recently created <u>World Council of Health</u> has expressed <u>very</u> <u>serious concerns</u> about this proposed global treaty. Under this treaty, the WHO would have the authority to arbitrarily declare pandemics and impose global measures that could erode the rights of individual countries to determine their own unique responses.

Many believe all of this planned 'prevention' may be much worse than management.

### Update: December 12, 2022

The Johns Hopkins University / Center for Health Security recently posted a summary of 4 of its recent '<u>Tabletop Exercises</u>' – simulations conducted to explore possible 'high-level strategic decisions and policies' that stakeholders might need to make in response to future global pandemics.

#### These 4 'tabletop exercises' posted were -

#### 1) Catastrophic Contagion (October 23, 2022)

Conducted by the Johns Hopkins Center for Health Security in partnership with WHO and the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation. Held in Brussels, Belgium. <u>Scenario focus</u>:

A future pandemic with a much higher lethality than COVID-19, affecting predominantly children and young people, and possibly requiring measures different, stronger, and earlier than those taken for COVID-19. Exercise discussion and plans were built on 'lessons learned' from COVID-19, particularly focusing on a more aggressive targeting and suppression of mis-dis-information.

#### 2) Event 201 (October 18, 2019)

Conducted by the Johns Hopkins Center for Health Security in partnership with the World Economic Forum (WEF) and the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation. Held in New York City, New York.

#### 3) Clade X (May 15, 2018)

Hosted by the Johns Hopkins Center for Health Security, in Washington, D.C.

# 4) Atlantic Storm (January 14, 2005)

A ministerial exercise convened by the Center for Biosecurity, the Center for Transatlantic Relations of the Johns Hopkins University, and the Transatlantic Biosecurity Network.

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The **COVID-19** 'Pandemic' began several months after the <u>Event 201</u> exercise that coincidentally simulated <u>a novel coronavirus pandemic outbreak originating in</u> <u>China</u>.

We are now several months after the <u>Catastrophic Contagion</u> simulation. Should we now be concerned about another 'real world' coincidence?

# 5) **Dark Winter** (June 22-23, 2001)

This simulation depicted 'a covert smallpox attack on US citizens'. Designed as a 'teaching and training resource for public health and government officials', it was held at Andrews AFB, Washington, DC.

# 6) Crimson Contagion

This pandemic simulation, involving a series of separate monthly exercises, ran from January to August 2019. It involved a large number of public-sector agencies and private-sector associations across 12 U.S states as well as the Trump administration's Dept of Health and Human Services.

This particular disease scenario was a respiratory virus that began in China and spread throughout the world by air travelers – initially, by 30 American tourists returning from a trip to China. It was first detected in Chicago, and within two months ultimately claimed 110 million sick Americans, 7.7 million hospitalized, and killed 586,000.
