E-note: central bank digital currencies (CBDCs) and cryptocurrencies

<u>Updated</u>: February 9, 2023 (in major revision)

<u>Central banks in most countries</u> are eagerly looking to introduce a centrally controlled form of 'virtual' or digital money (a <u>CBDC</u>) for routine retail payments. Secure, reliable, efficient, convenient, private. Governments everywhere consider CBDCs to be essential for a vibrant and competitive economy.

On March 16, 2022, the <u>Bank of Canada</u> announced <u>a 12-month research</u> <u>collaboration</u> with the <u>Massachusetts Institute of Technology</u> (MIT) to explore a CBDC for Canada. The Bank of Canada seems eager to introduce a CBDC but claims to have not yet made a final decision (as of March 16, 2022).

Central banks intend to carefully control and regulate their CBDCs. This would help ensure a stable currency value, just like money in a bank account. CBDCs would be usable only for commercial or retail payment transactions and would have no investment value. Hoarding of digital 'dollars' would not be possible. 'Virtual CBDC dollars' might even have an expiry date.

CBDC transactions would also be trackable, denying users the anonymity that 'cash' provides. While this monitoring could ostensibly help catch illegal transactions like money-laundering or tax evasion, it could also be used to track activities considered to be merely 'unacceptable' or outside approved societal 'norms'. A government could easily limit, block, or cancel a CBDC account for activities considered 'incorrect'.

A <u>decentralized</u> cryptocurrency like Bitcoin, on the other hand, would have no direct Central bank control or regulation. Transactions would be anonymous, not routinely tracked, and carried out on 'permissionless' public and open blockchain networks. Unlike a CBDC, a decentralized cryptocurrency would be usable as both a retail currency and investment asset.

Cryptocurrencies are volatile assets, well-suited for investment speculation. However, because of constant currency value fluctuations within a cryptocurrency account, this type of account would not provide the stability and predictability of a highly controlled CBDC.
