**<u>E-note</u>**: Erosion of fundamental human rights and freedoms

In Canada, many federal, provincial, and territorial laws exist to define and protect our fundamental rights and freedoms. We have long thought of these freedoms as guaranteed and unconditional – such as the freedom to express beliefs and opinions, freedom of religion, freedom of association and assembly, freedom of conscience, freedom of mobility, and a free press.

In practice, however, the pandemic experience of the past two years has shown that these profound legal rights and freedoms are neither absolutely guaranteed nor unconditional. At all levels, governments have arbitrarily enacted 'emergency' measures explicitly violating provisions of the Canadian 'Charter of Rights and Freedoms', long-standing health privacy laws, and well-established laws governing informed consent to medical procedures.

The most significant challenge now, as pandemic mandates begin to lift, is to restore protected rights and freedoms eroded or lost. Liberty-infringing emergency measures implemented to 'protect and keep us safe' must not be allowed to become permanent.
